President's Message

Dear Friends of UAI,

THE YEAR 2006 has been a very important one for the growth of Urantia Association International and the welfare of its mission. The members of the International Service Board and the Representative Council have been very busy progressing in their efforts to organize UAI, to make it more autonomous and interdependent of Urantia Foundation. During the past year, some members of the International Service Board have been engaged in the very complex work of registering UAI as a new charitable organization in the United States. This process in itself has necessitated many hours of work and has required the service of a lawyer. The registration is actually coming to an end and the year 2007 should become the first year of our newly acquired autonomy.

We have also seen UAI expand in a new country, Belgium. This new association should witness more growth in Europe and help expand the number of readers as well as new study groups. We have also given new chartering agreement to two local associations in South America that were once part of a single national association. The readers of Chile and Argentina who were once part of the Cono Del Sur Association now have the opportunity to expand their local association to the level of a national.

The year 2006 was also the first time that UAI held an international conference in a different continent of the world. The conference in Australia will be remembered as an important occasion to attract readers from this part of the world to attend an international conference. This was also the year to change the conference from a two-year cycle to a three-year cycle. This change was suggested by the International Service Board and adopted by the Representative Council in order to accommodate the



implementation of the upcoming strategic plan.

Another very important action was taken in 2006 - the work was begun to develop a strategic plan that would focus UAI in its far-reaching mission

to disseminate the teachings of *The Urantia Book*. Two reunions that lasted a few days each, were held in Chicago and many members of the International Service Board, as well as observers, attended those meetings. The final touch in the elaboration of this strategic plan should be completed in the first half of 2007. You will hear more about it as soon as further progress is made.

In December the International Service Board has submitted a resolution to the Representative Council asking approval of three restricted funds, one was for conferences, another for sponsorship to conferences and another for dissemination projects. The International Service Board hopes that the creation of those funds will attract certain groups of donors. The resolution was well received by the Representative Council and has been approved by a strong majority.

The International Service Board is in the final stage of approving certain changes made to the Charter and By-Laws so they can be in compliance with our new registration. Early in January the Representative Council will be called on to adopt this new version of the Charter and By-Laws, in doing so, it will finalize the legal process of registering UAI as a charitable organisation in the state of Illinois, USA.

At the beginning of the year, a UAI fund raising appeal will be sent to the USA membership, calling on their generosity, asking them to match a large donation from anonymous donors. Other countries are most welcome to participate in this effort to raise enough money to enable our

Among them was Mr. Urs Ruchti who has been responsible for the translation which took 13 years, Mr. Werner Sutter and Mrs. Irmeli Ivalo-Sjölie, the "good spirits" of the whole project, Mr. Jay W. Peregrine from the Urantia Foundation in Chicago, René Hagenaaars from Urantia Europe B.V., Michael MacIsaac from the UB Youth, and others.

How *The Urantia Book* Found Me - The Forgotten Promise

TODAY, MY NEIGHBOR, a blue eyed elderly man, saluted me for the first time. This nice man, retired, takes a morning and evening stroll with his dog. Good weather, bad weather, his little animal follows him courageously. So, we introduce each other on a beautiful summer evening; I was in a hurry to go back home, and his little dog, running off to smell the fragrant emanations in this neighborhood, made him wet by the evening dew.

It is eleven PM and I am now in bed. I had a good day of work; I am lying down, being almost comfortable. I am almost comfortable, because I am unhappy that I stopped sharing my faith for many years.

Alone in my bed, I think of the not too distant past when friendships were built and were lost, when love timidly exposed itself, when passions were lived in ecstatic happiness. It is eleven PM and a tear glides down my cheek. My soul has been sighing for more than ten years. What happened to the beautiful promises made by my Lord Jesus *"And I tell you, ask and you will receive; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you."* (Luke 11,9). My twenties were spent studying the Bible and ministering with my Pentecostal brothers and sisters. We were young and we were many, loving God. What wonderful moments I spent in the presence of all these people passionate about "The Word."

Then a strong wind came, a wind that wore me down; a wind of habits; a wind that troubles and causes us to fall into inferior material temptations.

I am alone in my big bed. I lack nothing. I live in a large apartment facing the river. I have absolutely marvelous work colleagues. Not feeling good or bad, my soul has nevertheless been sighing for many years. It is eleven PM and a tear glides down my cheek.

I remember all the nights when, before falling asleep, I repeated in my soul, for Jesus to hear: *"It is not your fault."* How



many times I repeated: *"It is not your fault."* How could I make you responsible for our own choices?

But how many times I asked you, as a soul that longs after love: *"Talk to me, I implore you to talk to me!"* Why have you turned away from me? I then thought I had been condemned for some obscure faults, fallen out of His grace, He whom I loved so much!

Remember your promises! How can you leave me in this world where cupidity and lying are omnipresent?

The old man with the blue eyes says "hello" to me almost every day now. That look filled with tenderness and serenity charms me; he is always smiling. One day, he introduces his wife and invites me over for coffee. We discuss, we sympathize, a new friendship has just blossomed.

Winter has arrived, he must leave my country to escape the cold. Mexico's warmth and sun heal his ailments that are not visible to my eyes.

That morning, before leaving, he looked at me sipping my coffee. He had in his hands a big blue book... The night before, I was thinking again about those promises that I had read in the Bible. How many times I read that Psalm *"I will instruct you and show you the way you should walk, give you counsel and watch over you."* (Psalm 32,8).

The old man said to me: "I am not bringing this book with me; it is too heavy for my luggage. And where I am going, I have access to it on the Internet." He looks at me and smiles one of those tranquil old person smiles and tells me: "Marie-Lise, return to

your first love! Continue to search and you will surely find!"

My old friend with the blue eyes left two days ago. I am in my bed; it is eleven PM; I open my big blue book. I leaf through, I look, I discover, but...how is this possible? I go back to the "Detailed Table of Contents." Tears of joy now slide down my cheeks and I remember these promises of old, *"I will instruct you and show you the way you should walk, give you counsel and watch over you."*

One night in February 1979, I was getting ready to read the Bible and to serve as Jesus recommended. One night in February 2001, I was getting ready to open a book called *"The Urantia Book,"* three blue circles were shown in the middle of the page.

Since that night, I learn, I discover, I make new friends and I share my most precious possession: "my faith." Is it possible that such a wonderful gift would be given to me? A spirit of praise and adoration rises in me. And that promise from the Book of Psalms, "I will instruct you." I had forgotten that promise!

I now live while attaching myself to this instruction. I am relearning service to others, because how can we love without wanting to serve others?

"Jesus taught that service to one's fellow is the highest concept of the brotherhood of spirit believers. Salvation should be taken for granted by those who believe in the fatherhood of God. The believer's chief concern should not be selfish desire for personal salvation but rather the unselfish urge to love and, therefore, serve one's fellows even as Jesus loved and served the mortal men." I have been reading *The Urantia Book* for a short time and already I have an irresistible desire to do something with my brothers and sisters. There is so much to do! And for those who let this love move them, there will not be any difficulty in finding their ministry in the field that attracts them. The difficulty will be to find a balance between service and simply living in love! ■

BACK IN THE YEAR 1967, I came home from a business trip on Thanksgiving Eve and arrived from the airport at about 10:30 PM. My daughter Linda had arrived home earlier with some student friends, and were seated in the kitchen dinette having a drink. I joined them and became involved in their discussions regarding some esoteric subjects regarding the ancient societies of Egypt, Peru and Mexico. One of the young ladies turned to me and said that she thought I would be interested in a book called "Urantia", and I asked her where I could obtain it. I am now almost 88 years of age and I am still reading *Urantia* and am still thrilled to read about the fantastic opportunities that lie ahead. Eons of time in which I can enrich my knowledge, enlarge my senses, enjoy the diversity of service and adventure as I progress through the Universes until at last I acquire the spiritual qualities that permit me to come face to face with God the Father.

I am deeply indebted to the young student who introduced me to *Urantia* and I use every opportunity, without being obnoxious, to introduce the book to people that I may chance to meet.

The Urantia Book has inspired me to express some of the thoughts to poetry and I am attaching a poem that I hope you will enjoy. □

Workshop Conference, Spiritual Relations and Growth

SUNDAY NOVEMBER 12th, 2006 at the Comfort Inn in St-Jérôme, Québec, a one day workshop conference was held where the theme was "SPIRITUAL RELATIONS AND GROWTH". Thirty eight persons had made the trip to listen to the presentations made by our six speakers.

This day required seven weeks of personal investment in meetings and preparation by our valiant volunteers to create the required group cohesion and unity. Each week, these co-authors of the conference thematic met to study the texts extracted from the U.B. and to ponder collectively. For me, the instigator of this project, it was a rich and elevating experience without precedent. What joy it was to support the inspiration that emanated from this group and to participate in it!

The theme was divided into sub-themes which each speaker specifically developed. The first sub-theme on the couple and family made us understand the fundamental role for each protagonist: that woman and man are so different and at the same time so compatible. We realized the repercussions of this co-creative association on the happiness of the children and on their future adult behaviour. We have considered it necessary

to re-establish the family in the forefront of our talks to raise the level of spiritual life.

The second sub-theme is a portrait of man and of society. We have deepened our understanding of the fact that when man has spiritual belief, he will bear fruits so as to share them, that the spiritual man has a major role to play in his environment.

As a continuation, two of the orators developed their sub-themes on spiritual fraternity. We reflected on the paradigm of the part versus the whole, and we rejoiced greatly to see that individual's progress benefited the entire fraternity. We appreciated the unity of spirit, the communion of souls without losing our individuality. Since personal religious experience is the corner stone of our relation with the Father, we further appreciate any additional experiences related to our peers in a spirit of ever renewing tolerance. What generosity from our brother when he shares his living relation with God!! He mirrors a face of infinity that was not accessible to us.

 Because I can't find the truth.

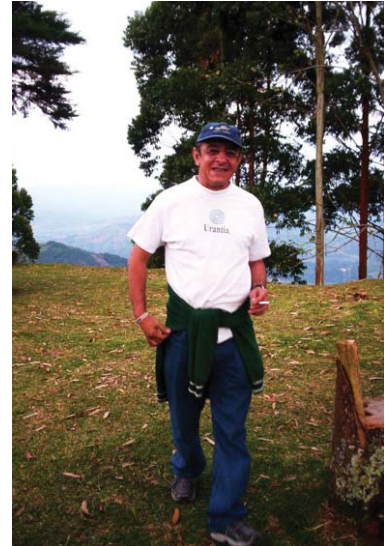

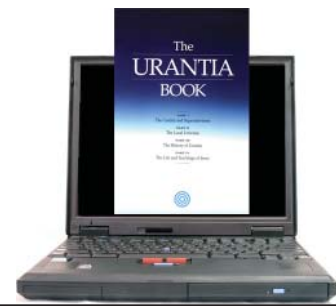
