Getting to know the Trustees: Georges Michelson-Dupont

The Prodigal Son

TO MY LOVING and lovable wife, Marlène, who was so patient and instrumental in influencing me to accept the teachings of *The Urantia Book*; to Jacques Weiss, who translated *The Urantia Book* into French and became my father's best friend; and to my father, Jacques Dupont, who gave me *The Urantia Book* – to these three persons I pay tribute, and for them, I say, "Thank you, Father".

In the late 1950s Jacques Weiss started translating *The Urantia Book* into French. In 1959, my father, Jacques Dupont, met Jacques Weiss at my father's favorite bookstore, "La Procure" in Paris. The owner of the bookstore knew that my father was a truth-seeker and spiritual explorer, and he introduced my father to Jacques Weiss (who was there -- apparently by chance), by saying to my father: "I know that you are looking for truth, and that you have never found it in any book that you have read. This man [Jacques Weiss] is translating a very intriguing book, and you should talk to him about it". Jacques Weiss showed my father the table of content of *The Urantia Book*. And within minutes my father was convinced of the importance of such a book, and he made arrangements to purchase a copy of the French translation of *The Urantia Book* when it was available.

In mid-1961 my father received a parcel, by registered mail, which contained a book, the French translation of Part I and Part II of *The Urantia Book*, which was eventually published in three volumes under the title *La Cosmogonie d'Urantia*. Immediately

he started reading the book and trying to find inconsistencies and other mistakes, as he had found in other "spiritual" texts. He could find none. He called Jacques Weiss and subsequently met him at Jacques Weiss's office. It was the beginning of a long friendship between these two men. When my father received the two other volumes, the French translation of Part III and Part IV of *The Urantia Book*, he continued to critically and sceptically study the book, as he was a Cartesian, scientifically minded person.

After a few months, having found no contradictions, inconsistencies, or other errors in the book, he realized that he was in possession of a revelation. His thirst for truth was finally quenched. He used to spend 3 hours every day studying the book and writing comments, which he shared with Monsieur Weiss.

I was 15 years old in 1962, when my father introduced me to *The Urantia Book*. He gifted me the 3 volumes of *La Cosmogonie d'Urantia*. Much to his disappointment, I was not interested. I was interesting in spending my time with my friends, playing guitar and singing in the streets of Paris.

This was my first reaction to the fifth epochal revelation!

There were meetings and gatherings of Urantia Book readers at our house and at the Weiss's residence, gatherings at which I was sometimes present, and at which I exhibited a modicum of curiosity. The Dupont and the Weiss families grew closer, and Jacques's wife, Simone Weiss, became my dentist. In 1967, Jacques and Simone Weiss and my mother and father travelled to the United States and visited Doctor Sadler in Chicago.

In December of 1965, while attending the Sorbonne in Paris, I met Marlène Vieux, a beautiful, intelligent, and charming philosophy student, who would become my wife. Three years before I met her, she and her family fled from Algeria because of the civil war there. They moved to Fontainebleau, France, where I was living at the time. Having experienced the uprooting of her life and her family's life in Algeria, having left almost all of their belongings, having lost all of their property there, and having started a new life in France, Marlène fell into depression. A few weeks after meeting her, I fell in love with her, and I desired to see her happy. I thought that she was looking for something that would give her hope and bring some balance into her life. I really do not know why, but I felt moved to give her the three volumes of *La Cosmogonie d'Urantia*. It was a miracle! It was like a rebirth. After reading it for a few months, Marlène discovered that, while she was an animal-origin being, she was indwelled by a fragment of God, a fragment of infinity,

spark of divinity, and ember of eternity. Thanks to the philosopher Jean Paul Sartre, she learned that Man is responsible for his destiny, and she realized that she could give eternal meaning to her destiny. Since 1966, when I gave her *The Urantia Book*, she has continued to read and study it. While Marlène's "taking" to the book was my second exposure to its teachings, I was still not interested in it. And it was certainly not a priority in my life, as it had become in the lives of my father and my future wife.

My third encounter with *The Urantia Book* occurred in the late 1970s, during a time of great tribulation and turmoil for me. Marlène and I had started a small business in the late sixties; it was a success. Then I decided to start another business to develop an idea that I had. It was a big mistake. I have a creative mind, I am a good salesman and technician, but I am a poor manager. I sunk all of our money and a lot of borrowed money into what became a disaster. Bankers were calling us at home, and document servers were serving us papers in connection with our being sued. Because of me, we were descending into financial hell. Anyone who has been there knows what I am talking about.

My life became increasingly difficult, my businesses collapsed, and my friends and relatives disappeared. They avoid me like the plague. In addition, my mother was dying of cancer.

What of Marlène? Did she stand with me unmoved? Yes! Angelically she supported me with Godlike, unconditional love and understanding, which made me feel even guiltier. As a consequence, I became depressed and contemplated suicide. I was miserable -- unhappy and guilty. One Sunday afternoon, I was slumped over, sitting on the side of our bed, crying and longing to be delivered from this misery and craving direction and love, when my eyes were directed toward the book shelves, where a copy of *The Urantia Book* sat. I remembered my wife's experience with the book when she was depressed. I stood up and took the book off the shelf. My life was a mess, in no small measure because I was not looking for the real values that bring joy and happiness in life. The example of Jacques Weiss's translating the book, the

example of my father's experiencing the book as a revelation, and the example of my wife's recovering from depression after commencing to read the book convinced me that I should read it.

I opened the book at random to page 1850, on which is a section titled "Parable of the Lost Son", the parable of "The Prodigal Son", Jesus' favorite parable. After reading the entire paper, an overwhelming feeling of relief and happiness filled my heart and soul. I realized that I was the prodigal son! I made a commitment to myself to read the book for at least fifteen minutes for the next fifteen days, starting with the Foreword. Not only did I read for at least fifteen minutes every day, I read for hours every day, and the fifteen days never ended because I am still reading the book.

From that memorable day, my life gradually changed. Marlène and I joined my father's study group, and we became involved in the Urantia community of readers. My father was, of course, overjoyed to see the change in his son's life.

When I look back at these experiences, I understand how the angels, the Thought Adjuster, the Spirit of Truth, and the Holy Spirit work together for our spiritual welfare. The angels used my decisions to manipulate the circumstances around me, as I was doing my will to execute my plans. My determination led me into a spiritual "cul de sac", from which I was forced to react. The angels put me in a position where I had a choice: to turn to God and ask for help or to turn away from God and sink into spiritual oblivion. My Thought Adjuster was heroic and instrumental because he was the one who made me long for love and crave direction in my life. He presented higher and supreme ideas and goals to my mind. The Spirit of Truth helped me to grasp the spiritual meaning and magnificent truths of the Parable of the Prodigal Son (which so accurately described me), and the Holy Spirit, through the 6th and 7th adjutant mind-spirit, sensitized me to the discovery of the fatherly nature of God.

Yes, it took three times (three opportunities) and nearly 15 years of perseverance for my Thought Adjuster to finally lead me to accept in my heart, mind, strength, and soul the necessity of God and faith in my

life. It was the struggle between my animal and my spiritual natures.

I thank my wife for her loving patience, tact, and tolerance during all those years of storm and drang.

I know many readers of *The Urantia Book* who are saddened by the fact that their mate is not interested in the book. But the book is only a tool – a marvellous tool -- that opens one's heart and mind to advanced cosmic truths and realities. But the real challenge is to establish a living relationship with one's indwelling divine fragment. To those friends I say: Be patient, tactful, and loving (like Marlène was for 15 long years), work hard, and never lose hope, for the ways of God are unfathomable. If "it" does not happen in this life, "it" will happen in the next. □

How *The Urantia Book* found me

MY NAME IS VOYETTE Perkins-Brown from Soul City, North Carolina. I am 65 years old, widowed in 2006 after a few years of separation, and have one really neat 38 year old son/brother from a former marriage. David and I are fortunate to love one another dearly. I found it necessary to retire because of a disability 10 years ago, having worked full time as a Medical Technologist

I minister to homebound persons who cannot get out to church services. I am reminded that it is the Thought Adjuster who accentuates the Divine Plan and motivates all who are seeking the Light of Mercy that prompts us to, (and I paraphrase here), "Act on your free will to knock that the door may be opened"; "Seek that you may find...the Peace of Jesus in your mind."

In retrospect I am convinced that this is exactly what occurred in my life a few decades ago. During a period of deep depression, and while hanging on to a very thin, unraveling straw of despair, I sought relief from the pain, at a local health clinic near my home. It was late that night, around 8:30 Dec 18, 1981, when I passed by the clinic. I had almost reached home, when I decided to turn around and go back. (The clinic was open late one night a week to meet the needs of the community.) I had not been a patient there for over a year, so I was not aware until that night, that the physician I had previously seen was no longer employed there. I was walking out the door when the receptionist came running after me, and walked me back to the desk.

"I thought that Dr. Perry was gone, but he is still here. Would you like to see him?" she asked. That was my first introduction to Dr. James H. Perry. A few weeks later at the clinic, I remember Dr. Perry stating that he had not ever expected to see me again, but was glad that I decided to come back for a follow-up.

To tell the truth, I was not interested in his assessment, but the medication he gave me seemed to be helping, and I had come back for a refill. On one subsequent visit as I was getting ready to leave his office, I saw this Big Blue Book on his desk. I read the name *The Urantia Book*, and asked if I could look it over. As I perused it in the office, words assaulted my vision. "The Love of God, The Nature of God, The Attributes of God," and phrases like that caught my curiosity. I thought that I had found a fantastic new book of Science Fiction.

That same day I ordered my own book from the Foundation.

When my book arrived I started discussing it with him, and soon afterwards we established our group called the "Truth Seekers", and began having meetings once a week. Friends and relatives also joined us. Over time we gave away a lot of books. (Smile)

In years to come, Dr. Perry would become mentor and guide to many of us UB readers.

Bible study, prayer meeting and UB group every week enabled me to discover many insights which resulted in a "Born Again Experience" for me in July of that same year. However, it was the soul wrenching ache of absolute pure joy that came

from the discovery that Jesus loved me that prompted me to enlist in the Gospel Ministry. Many are called, but I must admit that Jesus so overwhelmed me so with his compassion, forgiveness, and gentleness of spirit that I volunteered for service. My objective was to commit myself to a life of sharing the truth that Jesus really loves us.

In Dec. of 1982, I preached my initial sermon and was issued a license to preach. Two years later after study and much contemplation, I decided to seek ordination. I was refused twice, and at the last attempt was told not to come back until I could prove that God had something for me to do. Well the next day I was asked to pastor a small local church. What an experience, but one must remember the times; ordained female ministers were few and far between in the U.S. In the Baptist church... forget about it.

The day came when I was finally able to come before the Ordination Counsel. Twenty-five grown men packed the room, and I sat there petrified while they each in turn grilled me at length about my life's history, and what seemed like almost every line and paragraph in the Bible. Oh! My sisters and brothers it was a sight to see! Finally after two and a half hours everyone was exhausted. I tell you they did not want to give up. The moderator hung his head and asked if there were any more questions. A voice from the back rang out!

"What is your calling?"

I replied. "My calling is to reveal the Fatherhood of God and the Brotherhood of Man!"

Seriously, those great, learned men responded as if they had never heard anything so profound. It was that declaration of truth and faith that caused the moderator to declare that the conclave was over, and the time had come for the vote. I was Ordained a few weeks later.

I had to find a way to share those truths that had saved me. Once fear is removed so many people weep with joy to learn that they are truly loved by Jesus...they are truly cared for by the Lord. As a member of the clergy, I think that it would be wonderful

THE UAI HAS THREE international bodies: the RC, Representative Council, which is the legislative body, consisting of the Presidents and Vice-Presidents of the National Associations, the ISB, International Service Board, whose members are elected by the RC for a four-year term, and finally the Judicial Commission. The ISB is the executive branch of the UAI. The Judicial Commission, as its name indicates, is there to solve and settle disagreements between the governing bodies of the UAI or disputes between the associations or any other problems. In principle, the UAI is an organisation for co-operation between its constituent associations, and it would be nothing without the national and local associations inclusive their members. The members of the associations are the real field workers of our movement.

The Vice-President has a very thin job description in the Bylaws of the UAI, as long as everything runs smoothly. The Vice-President substitutes the President should the latter be unable to discharge his duties. The RC has not appointed or elected a chairman. The President functions as the leader of both the ISB and the RC. In order to somewhat ease off the presidential duties, the incumbent President and I agreed that the Vice-President will assume the chairmanship of the RC, so to enable the President to concentrate on chairing the ISB and being the spokesman of the whole UAI. The Vice-President is concurrently a member of the ISB and takes part in its proceedings.

To chair the RC is, by and large, very rewarding but also exacting. The RC is the most international of the bodies of the

UAI, with 14 nations represented, three of them enjoying an observer status. This means that there are fourteen different cultures involved, with their dissimilar ways of doing business. Some extra spice comes along with the different temperaments and ways of acting of the participating individuals. At the outset of my four-year term, we experienced some minor difficulties, or rather misunderstandings, but now the RC as a whole is functioning and working splendidly, with every participating individual really striving towards the best outcome in each issue at hand. For practical reasons, the RC is working by means of an unending online meeting. Technological advances and devices like the Internet and the email-system, enable the UAI to function as an indisputably international organisation.

One of the obstacles we have to face and overcome in international co-operation is the language barrier. The RC is conducting its business in three languages: English, French and Spanish. This is possible only because of the efforts of our skilful volunteer translators. My hope is that, in the future, the RC would focus solely on the item at hand, leaving and delegating other messages, opinions and discussions to other forums, like the UAI-forum; there are UAI forums in other languages, too.

I have learned a lot during these four years. I also know that two more 4-year terms in the offices of the ISB would be possible. But I believe in rotation and am aware of the fact that new persons always come with fresh ideas and new approaches. The principal reason for my decision to step down is that of making room for others to continue. I will continue as a member of the Finnish Urantia Association and be more active in other fields of the UAI in the future. I thank you for this opportunity I had to serve. God bless you all.

I wish to leave you with this quotation, of which I believe all readers of *The Urantia Book* do well if they keep it in mind:

The extent to which you have to go with your message to the people is, in a way, the measure of your failure to live the whole or righteous life, the truth-co-ordinated life. [1726:2].

Initially, when the Charter and Bylaws were being written, revised, debated, and revised again, my job as Charter Committee Chair required considerable time and effort. Since then, necessary corrections and amendments, and arranging for the translation of these has required less time. Occasional questions about meaning and intent of the governing documents are asked of me. To these I can only give my interpretation or opinion. Where intent is concerned, I often defer to Travis Binion who I nominated to replace me in the Chair position. Travis was involved in the conception of and the writing of the documents and has a better understanding of both intent and content than I.

Particularly in these formative stages of this now autonomous UAI, organizational changes and adjustments will be necessary and perhaps frequent. Both the Charter and Bylaws may require amendment to accommodate these changes. The Charter Committee chair will continue to insure that wording of the amendments is clear and concise, that language throughout both documents is consistent with the changes, and that neither document conflicts with the other as a result of amendments.

However, Will states that his greatest honor was being called upon to design the current cover of *The Urantia Book*.
